An Integrated Library



- The integrated chemistry library chemTK is located in the National Library of Technology building; all three collections (UCT Prague, IOCB, and NTK) are integrated
- Anyone can use the library, but most services require <u>registration</u>
- Some of the <u>EIR</u> are available only for a particular institution (IOCB, NTK or UCT Prague)
- By registering you gain access to electronic resources (including trial versions) and newsletters



Library Services (when you need a book)

- Registration is necessary for borrowing books
- You can borrow items for 28 days (extending the loan is possible)
- If you have any trouble with borrowing, ask us at the Central Desk on the second floor or at the Information Desk on the first floor
- NTK Library collection (printed books are located in Open Stacks)
- Some books are in storage, you can place a hold on books from Closed Stacks



Can't find a book or the full text of an article?

- Ask us for a <u>Domestic Interlibrary Loan</u> (in the Czech Republic) or the <u>International Interlibrary Services</u> (to order materials not available in Czech libraries)
 - When your order is settled, you will receive a notification message
 - This service is available to IOCB patrons as well






Other Library Services

STEMskiller is an annotated early career researcher skills map.

Targeted users are:

- Mentors of PhD students and postdoctoral researchers
- Research group and training program leaders
- Curricula developers.
- PhD students and postdoctoral researchers doing self-study

The structure of content is derived from the four competence areas:

- Research and scholarship
- Learning, teaching, and supervising
- 3. Career management
- 4. Engagement, involvement, collaboration, transdisciplinarity, and inquisitiveness

Each of the general competence areas includes sub-areas with pertinent skills and competences.
